Why Every Christian Is Called to Make Disciples

Following Jesus is about more than believing in Him. Jesus also calls us to help other people follow Him.

This calling is not only for pastors, missionaries, or church leaders. Every follower of Jesus can have a part in making disciples.

Jesus gave His followers a clear mission: “Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations.” — Matthew 28:19 (NKJV)

Jesus did not say, “Go and make church members.” He said, “make disciples.”

Jesus Calls Us to Follow Him

Before we can help someone follow Jesus, we must follow Him ourselves.

Jesus said: “Follow Me, and I will make you fishers of men.” — Matthew 4:19 (NKJV)

Notice the order. First, follow Jesus. Then, Jesus begins changing us.

As we spend time with Him, read His Word, pray, obey Him, and trust Him, we become more like Him. But our growth is not meant to stop with us. Jesus wants to work through us to reach others.

You Have Something to Share

You may think, “I do not know enough about the Bible.” You do not need to know everything. Share what Jesus is teaching you.

If God teaches you about forgiveness, share it. If He helps you through a hard season, tell someone what you learned. If a Bible verse changes your thinking, share that truth.

Paul told Timothy: “The things that you have heard from me... commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.” — 2 Timothy 2:2 (NKJV)

That is discipleship. Someone helps you grow. You help someone else grow. Then that person helps another person.

Disciple-Making Happens in Everyday Life

Making disciples does not require a stage or a large group. It can happen around a kitchen table. It can happen over coffee. It can happen during lunch with a coworker or during a conversation with a friend.

Read Scripture together. Pray together. Talk about life. Encourage each other. Help one another obey what Jesus teaches.

Discipleship is life shared with Jesus at the center.

Jesus Has Given You a Mission

God can use ordinary people to make an eternal difference. You do not have to reach hundreds of people. Start with one.

Ask God to place someone in your life whom you can encourage, teach, pray with, and help follow Jesus. Then help that person learn to do the same for someone else. This is how disciples multiply.

Take Your Next Step

Do not wait until you feel like an expert.

Follow Jesus. Grow in His Word. Walk with someone else. Help them follow Jesus too.

The Great Commission belongs to every follower of Christ. You have a part in it. Your part may begin with just one person.
