Spiritual growth should not stop with you.

Jesus wants His followers to make disciples.

Before returning to heaven, Jesus said, **“Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations.” — Matthew 28:19 (NKJV)**

That command is not only for pastors and missionaries.

Ordinary Christians can help people follow Jesus.

You do not need to know every answer. You do not need a Bible degree. You do not need to be a perfect Christian.

Start with what God has already taught you.

Maybe you can read the Bible with someone.

Pray with a friend.

Encourage a new Christian.

Share how Jesus changed your life.

Invite someone to church.

Teach your children about Jesus.

Help another believer understand something God has taught you.

Disciple making can begin with one person.

Growing Disciples Help Others Grow

As you help someone grow, something powerful can happen.

You grow too.

You may begin praying more because someone is depending on you.

You may study God's Word more carefully because you want to explain it clearly.

You may pay more attention to the way you live because someone else is watching your example.

Your faith begins moving beyond yourself.

That is an important part of spiritual maturity.

Think about what could happen if one Christian helped one person follow Jesus.

Then that person helped another.

Then those people helped others.

Spiritual growth begins multiplying.

You do not need a classroom or a large group to begin.

Start with one person.

Ask someone how you can pray for them. Read a chapter of the Bible together. Talk about what God is teaching you. Encourage them when following Jesus becomes difficult.

Most importantly, show them what following Jesus looks like through the way you live.

Do not wait until you believe you know enough.

You will always have more to learn.

Follow Jesus faithfully today. Then reach back and help someone else take their next step toward Him. Growing disciples do not only grow—they help other disciples grow too.

Take the Next Step

Making disciples may sound like a big job, but it often begins with one small step. You do not have to gather a crowd. You do not have to teach a long lesson. You can begin with one person God has placed in your life.

Think about a friend, family member, neighbor, or church member. Ask God to show you who may need help following Jesus. Then pray for that person by name. Look for a simple way to spend time together.

Keep It Simple

Disciple making does not need to be hard. Open the Bible and read a short passage together. Ask, "What does this teach us about God?" Then ask, "What should we do because of what we read?"

Pray together. Share what God is teaching you. Be willing to listen when the other person has questions. You may not know every answer. That is okay. You can say, "I do not know, but we can look for the answer together."

Your life also teaches. People notice how you speak, forgive, serve, pray, and handle hard days. They need more than your words. They need to see what following Jesus looks like in everyday life.

Help Them Help Someone Else

Jesus did not call us only to gain knowledge. He called us to make disciples. That means we should help people grow until they can help someone else grow too.

Imagine helping one person learn to pray, read the Bible, obey Jesus, and share their faith. Then that person begins helping another person. One life touches another life. The work keeps moving forward.

This is how disciple making can multiply. It does not depend on one pastor doing everything. Ordinary believers can take part in the mission of Jesus.

Start Today

Do not wait until you feel ready. You may never feel fully ready. Start with what you know. Share what Jesus has done in your life. Read Scripture with someone. Pray with them. Encourage them to obey what God shows them.

Matthew 28:19 says, "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations" (NKJV).

Ask yourself one question today: "Who can I help take one step closer to Jesus?"

Write down one name. Pray for that person. Then take one simple step.

Follow Jesus. Help someone else follow Jesus. Then teach them to do the same.
