How to Obey God When It Is Difficult

Learn why obedience matters and how faith helps us follow God when His way is not the easy way.

Obedying God is easy when His way matches ours. But what happens when it does not? What happens when God asks you to forgive someone who hurt you? Wait when you want an answer? Trust when you cannot see what He is doing? That is when obedience becomes an act of faith.

"If you love Me, keep My commandments."

- John 14:15 (NKJV)

Obedience is not just following rules. **It is trusting God enough to follow Him.**

Trust God When You Cannot See the Way

Sometimes God leads us down a road we do not understand. Abraham experienced this when God called him to leave his home.

"And he went out, not knowing where he was going."

- Hebrews 11:8 (NKJV)

Abraham did not have every answer. He had God's direction. Sometimes we want God to show us the whole plan before we obey. But faith takes the next step even when we cannot see the whole road.

You do not have to understand everything to trust the One leading you.

Obey Even When It Costs You

Obedience can be difficult. God may ask you to give up something. Forgive someone. Tell the truth. Wait. Serve. Change direction. Walk away from sin. You may even have to stand alone.

Jesus showed us what obedience looks like. Before the cross, He prayed:

"Nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done."

- Luke 22:42 (NKJV)

Real obedience says: "God, I want Your will more than my own."

Do Not Let Fear Make the Decision

Fear often stands between us and obedience. What will happen? What will people think? What if I fail? What if God's way is harder?

"Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid... for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."

- Joshua 1:9 (NKJV)

Courage does not mean you never feel afraid. Courage means fear does not get to choose your path.

Faith moves forward because God is with you.

Take the Next Step

You may not know what happens after you obey. That is where trust begins.

What has God already shown me to do?

Then take the next step. Forgive. Wait. Pray. Speak the truth. Turn away from sin. Help someone. Trust God. Do what His Word says.

Obedience is not about controlling the outcome. Obedience is about trusting God with the outcome.

Keep Walking

Following Jesus will not always lead down the easiest road. Sometimes His path is narrow. But you do not walk it alone.
